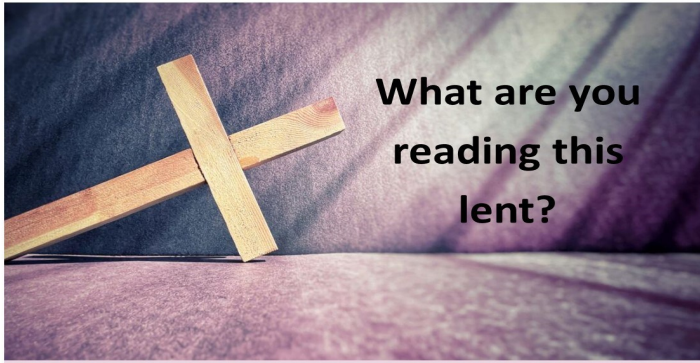
Heather Steed.

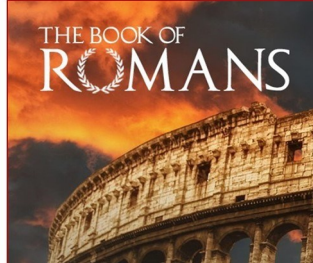

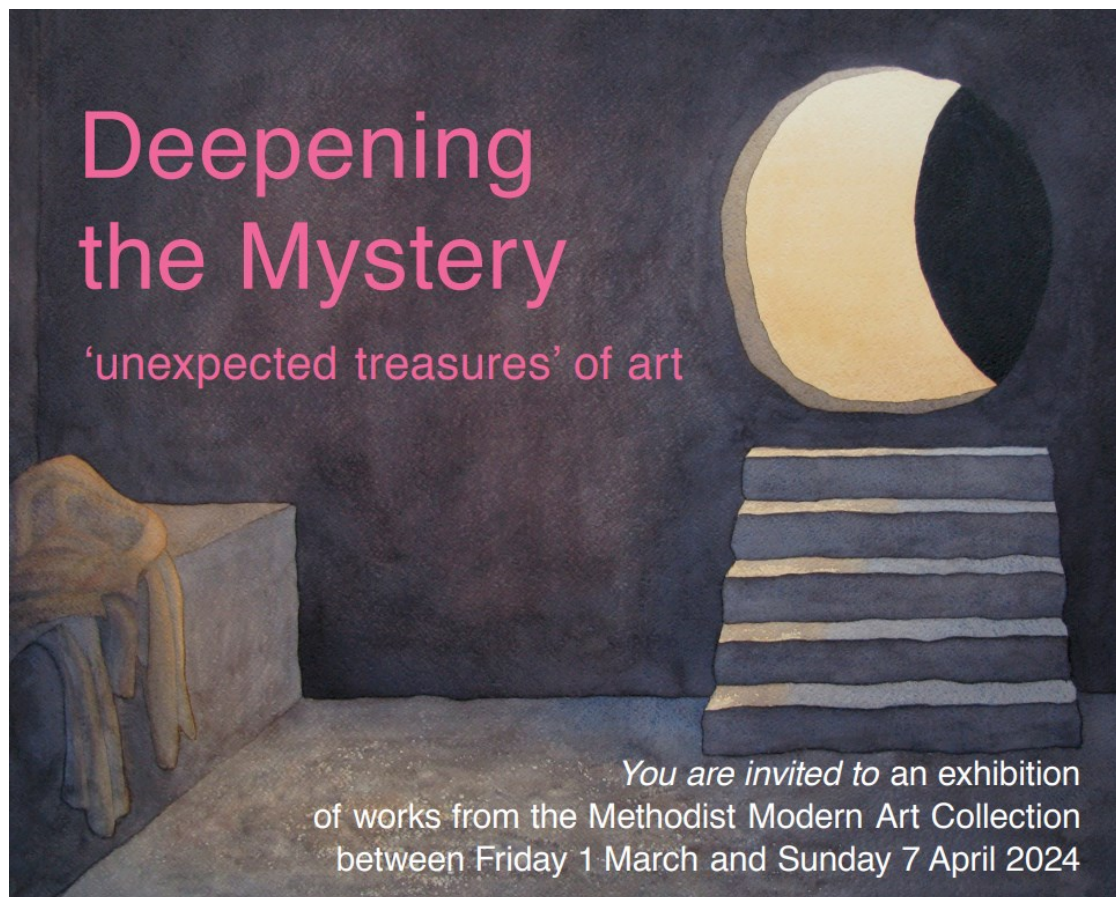
