Thank you for your donation to the Middle East Crisis Appeal that Christian Aid launched in response to the terrible events and desperate humanitarian situation in Israel and the Occupied Palestinian territory. So far, churches like yours have come together and raised over £1.3m to provide essential humanitarian relief and psychological support to those who have been impacted. I thought you might appreciate an update on Christian Aid's response.

Our partners in Gaza have been responding as best they can, under intense pressure, with medical relief and community-led initiatives such as food, shelter, sanitation and cash. However, it is extremely dangerous to move around, and supplies of essentials are running perilously low.

Since early November, Christian Aid has been working with Zochrot, an Israeli civil society organisation based in Tel Aviv. We are supporting them to provide trauma based psychological assistance to Israelis who have been affected by the escalation of violent conflict since the 7th October. Christian Aid is also funding Zochrot to continue their ongoing community-based work with Israelis.

During the recent humanitarian pause Christian Aid's partners continued to work hard. It was an opportunity to meet each other, to assess the damage and to plan for further violence. For example, centres in Khan Younis sheltering displaced people have been working together to learn lessons and share experiences to plan. Each centre has an emergency committee that meets daily and those committees met up during the pause to see what can be improved. This has allowed different centres to learn from one another.

Some of our other partners have been able to go back to their offices in Gaza city to assess the damage. While buildings are standing, they have sustained heavy damage. Our partner, PARC, is now managing to provide cash vouchers for people in the North. They're struggling to deliver food packages, so cash is a good alternative.

We have also been able to contact at least one partner that had stopped responding during the energy / telecoms blackouts. They're trying to assess the situation for their staff and we'll soon be sending a grant for them to provide stipends to help them to survive. They're making microgrants via Christian Aid funding to small, local associations to provide blankets, clothes and mattresses for the people sheltering with them.

There is still a lot of need and uncertainty, but none of this work would be possible without churches, like yours, generously giving, campaigning and praying for a fairer world, in which everyone can thrive.
