AUGUST ECO TIP.

Water efficiency: In the garden



Use a watering can or a hose with a trigger-release to water plants for more direct and efficient watering.



Get a butt!

A water butt can capture rainfall, allowing you to use it in your garden.



Choose plants that are appropriate for your local climate. A lot of native British plants are drought resistant.



Dropped some ice cubes? Don't throw them in the sink, save the water and give them to a thirsty plant instead!



Use a bucket of water, or a trigger-release hose to improve water efficiency when you're washing your car.



Water your garden when temperatures are low to reduce evaporation levels and improve efficiency!



Don't over-water your lawn. New lawns only need watering for four weeks, and established lawns don't need watering at all.



Innovate - think of your own ways to save water in the garden and less us know using the hashtag #SaveWater!



Reuse is a great way to save both water and money. If you wash up in a bowl, you can reuse the water for your plants.
