Items can be brought to the church and left in the garage.

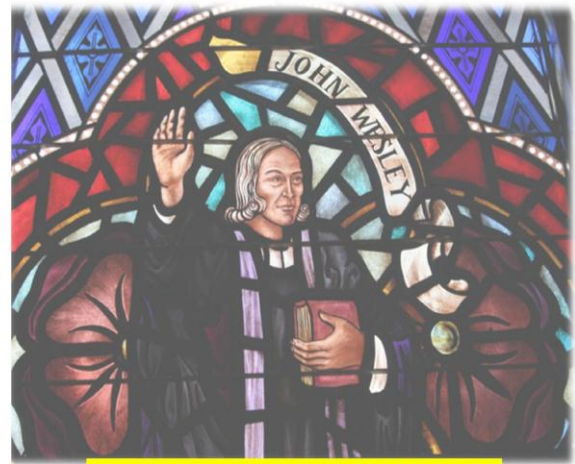
COLLECTION AVAILABLE
